



- ❑ Participants : 195 (129 F – 66 M)
- ❑ Mean age : 52.9 Y (range 41 – 76 Y, SD 5.4)
- ❑ Cases of rhizarthrosis : 46 (35 F – 11 M)
- ❑ OR for rhizarthrosis after 10 Y FT overall exposure : 1.53 (1,03 – 2,28)




Rhizarthrosis or arthrosis of the CMC1-joint



Sound advice for every OHP !

- ✓ Screen for rhizarthrosis in early stage
- ✓ Screen in jobs involving repetitive and forceful gripping and pinching
- ✓ Ask for problems opening jars
- ✓ Do the Cyriax-test
- ✓ Look for other RSI in case of rhizarthrosis
- ✓ Film every repetitive job
- ✓ Stay alert for atypical symptoms...

OCRA-Index and OCRA-checklist score

OCRA-score	OCRA-index	RISK
$\leq 7,5$	$\leq 2,2$	No risk
7,6 – 11	2,3 – 3,5	Limited risk
11,1 – 14	3,6 – 4,5	Low risk (X2)
14,1 – 22,5	4,6 - 9	Medium risk (X3)
$> 22,5$	> 9	High risk (X4)



OCRA-scores for six types of banknote processing

Activity	Left upper limb	Right upper limb
Controlling banknote sheets ('Fan' technique	8,5	11,5
Manual counting	19	19
Boxing new banknotes	5	11
Opening Cash bags	16	16
Operator on BPS3000	9	17
Operator on BPS1000	13,5	13,5



Manipulations perceived as strainful for the thumb by workers vs. the OCRA score.

Manipulation Thumb+	OCRA-score Left <u>upper limb</u>	OCRA-score Right <u>upper limb</u>
Controlling banknote sheets (‘fan’technique)	8,5	11,5
Manual counting/supervisor	19	19
Operator BPS3000	9	17
Unpacking cash bags	16	16
Operator BPS1000	13,5	13,5
Stocking cash bundles	14	14
